

Dear Good Gentle:

Your reservation has been received for the upcoming event hosted by Thor's Mountain. It was noted that you intend to bring a child age twelve or under to our event. We are pleased that you are choosing to share this experience with a child. Please take a moment to review the following Kingdom Law as found under "Article VII: Rights and Duties of the Populace" at [www.Meridies.org](http://www.Meridies.org) regarding children at events:

**VII-107 Children**

- (A) Children under the age of legal consent must attend any official Society function in the company of a parent or legal guardian or have a letter of parental consent which designates the adult responsible for the child and consent for the child to be treated in the case of a medical emergency, as well as a signed standard waiver.
- (B) The adult in charge of the child is responsible for any and all acts of the child.
- (C) The child must be in the company of the adult specified by the letter of parental consent to attend any official S.C.A. function if the parent or legal guardian is not present at the event.
- (D) The adult, not the child, is responsible for the keeping of the consent form.
- (E) Such a letter must be presented to the autocrat and those at the registration area in charge of waivers and attendance records for their perusal before the child will be admitted to the site. The waiver must be retained by whomever is collecting such for that event.
- (F) Children should not be left unattended at events. Children under the age of 12 must be within the sight or voice range of a designated responsible adult or teenager at all times. Failure to do so may result in sanctions ranging from expulsion from site to notification of mundane authorities depending on the circumstances.
- (G) For any SCA, Inc . sponsored children's activity ("goslings", Page School, Youth Combat, etc.) there must be two (2) unrelated (non-married, non-dating, non-kin) adults in charge for the duration of the activity.

**In addition to Kingdom Law, our Baronial Event Policy states that children under the age of five must be accompanied by a responsible adult or teenager at all times.** Our event sites often contain potential hazards such as waterways, campfires, weapons, and the presence of strangers. As such, the Barony asks that you adhere to Kingdom Laws and our event policies as they are in the best interest of your child. Failure to adhere to our policy and Kingdom Law will be addressed by our Autocrat(s) and Seneschal per Kingdom Law and enforced by our Constable.

Please consult our event schedule once on site for planned Children's Activities for ages five to twelve. You may be asked to volunteer some of your time to help with these activities if your child chooses to participate. Children who are disruptive may be returned to your care at the discretion of the Minister of Children. We look forward to seeing you and your child at our event.
